Welcome and Introductions

Chair David Pierce called the meeting to order at 2:32 pm.

Review minutes from April Meeting

Motion by David to approve 4/21/21 minutes, seconded by Alison and carried unanimously.

Corridor Management Plan (CMP) Review/Adoption

Adam gave a detailed review of the updated CMP, noting which sections have changed since the original 2008 plan. He said that the original goals have been pared down significantly due to lack of robust council involvement.

Adam noted that Monique has put a lot of work into the Inventory of Intrinsic Qualities (Resource Inventory) but that further town input is needed before this appendix to the CMP can be finalized. Those present agreed to provide more input, including one-paragraph writeups and photos, for the resources in question. David noted that this element of the CMP is more of a “living document” and can be updated as needed.

Monique will be in touch with councilmembers over the next month with specific information requests.

Motion by Alison to adopt CMP Update, seconded by Dick and carried unanimously.

Other Business

Alison mentioned the dangers of bicycling along Routes 13 and 77 in New Boston and Weare. David suggested penning a letter to NH DOT on behalf of the byway, notifying them of these local concerns.

Given the requirement to meet at least annually, and the completion of the CMP, it was decided to meet again in one year’s time. Resource Inventory work will continue in the coming months.

Motion by Dick to adjourn, seconded by Alison. The meeting was adjourned at 3:12.
